The Pony of the Americas Club, Inc. annually sponsors scholarships for outstanding youth. The scholarships are perpetuated through memorial funds, endowments, state club and chapter donations, individual donations, plus POAC special scholarship activities. Presently POAC awards four \$1000 scholarships a year. The scholarship can only be won once. Each application is carefully reviewed by a scholarship committee outside of POAC.

In order to apply for a POAC scholarship the youth must be a graduating senior in high school with the youth and their family a member of POAC and showing POAs. Any qualified youth will be provided a scholarship application upon request or the application can be downloaded off the POAC home web page or found in the December edition of the POAC magazine. Deadline for application is postmarked March 1st and to be received in the POAC office no later than March 10th. Your high school will be notified May 1st if you have received the scholarship so that you can be recognized at your awards banquet and/or graduation. You will also be recognized at the International Show as well as a recipient. No youth who is a member of the immediate family of a paid employee of the POAC, Inc. may be considered as a nominee for an award.

The grants from the Scholarship Fund will be payable only to an institution to which the recipient is attending to further his or her education. These funds are not transferable from the person receiving the award. The scholarship is only available for one calendar year from September to September. If the scholarship has not been requested from the recipient after that time period they forfeit their scholarship.

General Information:

1. Any boy or girl who is a member of a POAC family or a Junior member, showing POAs, and is a graduating high school senior is eligible.
2. The applicant must complete, sign, and return an application to the POAC by or before the deadlines to be eligible. Please type or print legibly on the application. Essays must be typed. It is to the applicant's advantage to make a neat, complete, and informative application due to the degree of competition and skills of other applicants.
3. Selection for this scholarship is based upon: POAC activities, school and community activities, scholastic aptitude, and general information provided in the essays.
4. Three letters of personal recommendation, with one being from a POA member, and one from a teacher. No recommendations can be from a relative.
5. All applications and requirements are due in the home office postmarked no later than March 1st and received no later than March 10th to be considered for the scholarships.
